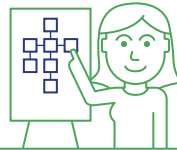
LIGHTNING TALKS

Lightning talks are strictly timed 5-minute presentations that provide an opportunity for new ideas and community newcomers to gain visibility. Lightning talks are a great way to show how your organisation deals with e-infrastructures or international research collaborations. Other topics are of course also welcome!



POSTERS

Posters will be displayed in the conference exhibition area, where presenters will have opportunities to explain their work to EaPEC participants, making new contacts and gaining feedback on their work and ideas.



Policy makers, research managers, experts on networking, cultural heritage and high-performance computing for research and education are invited to submit proposals for posters and lightning talks for the 3rd Eastern Partnership E-infrastructure Conference, EaPEC 2018.

HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR IDEAS

Proposals for EaPEC 2018 posters and lightning talks should be submitted as 300-word abstracts to: submit_eap@geant.org.

Although you may submit more than one topic for consideration, for each topic that you submit you should please indicate whether it would be presented as a poster only, or as a lightning talk with a poster.

Topics of interest include, but are not limited to, the following: e-infrastructure Applications, Open Science, Research Data Management, Data Science, Digital Libraries & Cultural Heritage Digitisation, High-performance Computing, e-Science.



Organised by the Eastern Partnership Connect (EaPConnect) project, EaPEC 2018 will be hosted by RENAM in Chisinau, Moldova, on 17-18 October 2018.

Posters and lightning talks are great ways for EaPEC participants to share early results, get feedback on shared ideas, find new collaborators from other institutions, and spark conference discussion.

SELECTION

Abstracts will be evaluated by the lightning talks and posters chair(s) with respect to their relevance to EaPEC's audience and the availability of space in the conference program. Abstracts will not receive peer-review feedback. Accepted abstracts will be made available on the conference website prior to the event.
